Minutes of Prior Recreation Meeting Approved

No Audience for Citizens

Treasurer's Report: Kaye Johnson submitted 2009-10 Commission Programs to date, current balance \$11,402.66, Total Loss for year \$1,088.35, although Bob Johnson reported that approximately \$950-1000 still owing from Town of Chaplin and \$75.00 from Town of Columbia (Tournament fee)

Youth Sports:

- Discussion of Soccer registration to take place in fall 2010 for grades K-2 instructional programs.
  - Troy Lake brought up discussion on advertising for registration. Resolution unanimously passed to spend up to \$200.00 for advertising, publicity related to Fall 2010 youth soccer.
  - Troy Lake reviewed regional programs for children who want to play in formal leagues, programs currently available in Brooklyn, Canterbury and WAM, registration takes place directly with those organizations/towns.
- Discussion followed comments from last meeting regarding whether Youth Sports should be separated from the Recreation and Community Activities Commission, no formal action although Bob Johnson to discuss with BOS.
- Bob Johnson reported on Parish Hill Basketball Camp, have raised over \$1,000 in sponsorships, overall success with registrations, exact numbers to follow, Insurance being handled with rider from Town policy.

Summer Music Series:

Discussion commenced with concern over programs and funding.

- As to 7/14/10 Outdoor concerns, Bob Johnson indicated might have a couple of donors, have orally committed to group, by unanimous resolution, voted to approve \$500.00 to fund concert. Stressed need to get out publicity, Bob Johnson to contact Gazette, send press releases and get out word of this event. Time is of the essence. Bob Johnson to meet with Kaye Johnson to get publicity done ASAP.
- Flock Theater/Tempest, date 8/20/10, Ann Flammang indicated that she has raised \$350.00 in donations and has a unanimous donor who will make up the difference between the donations and the \$1,000 fee for the event. Commission unanimously approved spending up to \$500.00 for publicity and other costs associated running this event,
- Mark Davis reported on upcoming concerts, three for fall, usual \$10.00 admission charge with proceeds as follows \$350.00 to performers, next \$100.00 to Hampton Rec

and split in half all proceeds in excess of \$450.00. Stressed need to get Mark help with publicity/advertising. Kay Johnson volunteered to work with Mark.

Tabled discussion on By laws, Budget Planning and membership

Gordon Hansen reported that the Gazette no longer looking for a donation

Troy Lake reported that he attended recent BOS meeting and Air line trail improvements as a bike/walking trail are in the works, grant money to be available. More details to follow.

Tabled discussion on Playscape.
