Special Town Meeting

The legal voters and those qualified to vote in Town Meeting are hereby warned to assemble in Town Meeting at the Hampton Town Hall, Community Room, 164 Main Street in Hampton, Connecticut on **Wednesday, June 18, 2014 at 7:00 p.m.** to transact the following business:

1. Call to order.
2. To elect a moderator for said meeting.
3. To hear discussion on the Hampton Elementary School Education Budget for FY July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015 as recommended by the Board of Finance, and to appropriate sums of money as required.
4. To hear discussion on the question of "Shall the Town of Hampton approve moving \$100,000 from the Capital Non-Recurring Land Acquisition fund to the Capital Non-Recurring Building Fund for the purpose of finishing improvements at the Town Hall?"
5. To hear discussion and act on the question of "Shall the Town of Hampton approve closing out and moving \$1608.76 from the Capital Non-Recurring Town Garage fund to the Capital Non-Recurring Building Fund for the purpose of finishing improvements at the Town Hall?"

Adjournment.

At its meeting held on June 10, 2014, the Board of Selectmen voted, pursuant to Section 7-7 of the Connecticut General Statutes, that items 3 and 4 on the call of the June 18, 2014 Special Town Meeting be submitted to referendum vote on June 26, 2014 between the hours of Noon and 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall, 164 Main Street, Hampton, CT.

The designation of the questions on the ballot for said referendum vote shall be as follows:

1. "Shall the Town of Hampton appropriate \$2,187,089 for the Hampton Elementary School for the 2014-2015 fiscal year?"
2. "Shall the Town of Hampton approve moving \$100,000 from the Capital Non-Recurring Land Acquisition fund to the Capital Non-Recurring Building Fund for the purpose of finishing improvements at the Town Hall?"
