1. Call to order.
2. To elect a moderator for said meeting.
3. To hear discussion on the General Government Budget for FY July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 as submitted by the Board of Selectmen, and to appropriate sums of money as required.
4. To hear discussion on the Hampton Elementary School Education Budget for FY July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 as submitted by the Board of Education, and to appropriate sums of money as required.

Adjournment.

At its meeting held on June 19, 2012, the Board of Selectmen voted, pursuant to Section 7-7 of the Connecticut General Statutes, that item 3 and 4 on the call of the June 26, 2012 Special Town Meeting be submitted to referendum vote on July 10, 2012, between the hours of Noon and 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall, 164 Main Street, Hampton, CT.

**The designation of the questions on the ballot for said referendum vote shall be as follows:**

1. "Shall the Town of Hampton appropriate **\$1,719,588** for the General Government for the 2012-2013 fiscal year?"
2. "Shall the Town of Hampton appropriate **\$2,256,188** for the Hampton Elementary School for 2012-2013 fiscal year?"
