The date of receipt of a petition, application, request or appeal shall be the day of the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Agency, immediately following the day

of submission to the Agency or its agent of such petition, application, request or appeal or thirty-five (35) days after such submission, whichever is sooner [Town Of Hampton, Connecticut Inland Wetlands And Watercourses Regulations Sec. 8, 8.4].
