#### **Next Steps**

- The Public Works Foreman was asked to outline what constitutes the different levels of Public Works Laborer (laborer only, mechanic, etc.).
- It was decided that the Library Board and the Board of Selectmen/Finance would be asked to come to a consensus concerning the Librarian whether the position is a town employee or a library employee, because she is supervised by the Library Board but paid by the town. Penny questioned how the problem occurred in the first place and expressed frustration with the "secrecy" behind the conflicts in the status (salaried vs hourly, employee of the town vs the library) of the Librarian; she felt strongly that all policies regarding personnel must be plainly laid out in a handbook or the town personnel policy manual.
- It was discussed that a comparison of benefits and salaries, as well as responsibilities and levels of support, in other towns should be made.
- It was decided that the 1<sup>st</sup> Selectman's salary is the priority position for a substantial increase, but doubtful that it could happen, based upon the current economic climate.
