Ms. Willhoit reported that Brian Mahoney, of the State Department of Education told her the BOE will be receiving either \$78,209 or \$44,855 from the Education Jobs Fund Program. REAP funds of \$23,213 will also be available. Ms. Willhoit suggested that \$18,012 of the funds be used to hire a .2 Full Time Equivalent prekindergarten teacher for \$9,130 and a .5 Full Time Equivalent paraprofessional to assist in the prekindergarten classrooms

Other areas of need include expanding the math support teacher position from half time to full time.
