Acceptance of October's minutes. None available; tabled.

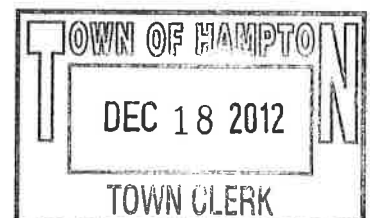
Audience for citizens. None.
