Old Business:

- 1. Maurice and Rita Edwards Preserve. A trail race in June will utilize the area, as well as Goodwin S.F. Chairman T. will check on progress of the kiosk. The bike path may be expanded.
- 2. Open Space Grant application. DEEP said we may not know status until September. Waiting is ok with the sellers...for now. There were many fewer applications than past years, so chances of being accepted look good.
- 3. PoCD revision underway by P & Z. A townwide questionair is being worked up, and will be available to residents on line or by paper. The new Plan of Conservation and Devalopment must be finished in a little more than a year.

New Business:

- 1. Station Road Ash. Finally had to be cut down. It was about 5 and one half feet in diameter, 17 ffet in circumference and at least 170 years old.
- 2. South Cemetary. The wall needs work. Many areas falling away, the results of a hard winter..? The Cemetary Association is getting bids for repair work.
- 3. Native plants in danger. Marcia Kilpatrick said we could help by eliminating non-natives and helping to promote native plants.
