that will be included in the new PoCD was passed out to members.  
Mention of the public hearing of the adoption of the new PoCD  
will be November 28, 2016.
2. Invasive plant conference, Marcia said it was well attended, ~~wn~~  
with excellent speakers. There was a huge display, and discussion  
of eradication methods.
3. GSF maps. Stan mentioned Friends of Goodwin ~~will~~ include the  
trails on Town property adjacent to GSF in thair maps. Also,  
the GSF grant application for invasive removal work is going to  
the Federal Government for review.
