A special meeting of the Board of Selectmen was held on Tuesday, March 19, 2013 at the Town Hall.

Present for the Board: First Selectman Allan Cahill, Selectman Bob Grindle, Selectman Mike Chapel

ITEM 1: Call to Order: First Selectman Cahill called the meeting to order at 11:06 a.m.

ITEM 2: Audience for Citizens

ITEM 3: Budget Workshop Session

Selectmen discussed backing off on contributions to the open space account (to \$1.00), leaving building maintenance and emergency management the same, increasing insurance contributions to employees to 15% for both single and family plans, eliminating transfer station sticker fees (residents to receive sticker once taxes are paid), decreasing Board of Finance administration line item to \$4,000 and Utilities to \$9,000.

Social Security and Simple IRA contributions would increase with any increases in salaries.

Public Works payroll add \$6,000 and a 1% increase for Building Inspector salary.

Regina DeCesare asked how many towns the building inspector works for and why Hampton pays the health insurance, and the history/ compensation of that position was explained.
