**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town of Hampton, Connecticut will conduct a public hearing by the Board of Selectmen on Thursday, March 17, 2016, at 6:00 p.m. at the Hampton Town Offices, 164 Main Street, Hampton, CT 06247, to the discuss the Fiscal Year 2016 Community Development Block Grant program, report on the progress of current and recent grants, and to solicit citizen input.

Maximum award limits are: \$700,000 for Public Facilities; \$700,000 for Public Housing Modernization of 25 units or less, or \$800,000 for 26 units and over; \$500,000 for Infrastructure; \$400,000 for Housing Rehabilitation Program for single towns; \$500,000 for two-town consortium, and \$600,000 for three or more towns; \$25,000 for Planning Only Grants; \$500,000 for Economic Development Activities; and \$500,000 for Urgent Need.

Major activity categories are: Acquisition, Housing Rehabilitation, Public Housing Modernization, Community Facilities, Public Services, and Economic Development. Projects funded with CDBG allocations must carry out at least one of three National Objectives: benefit to low- and moderate-income persons, elimination of slums and blight, or meeting urgent community development needs.

The purpose of the public hearing is to obtain citizens' views on the Town's community development and housing needs and review and discuss specific project activities in the areas of housing, economic development or community facilities which could be part of the Town's application for funding.

Also, the public hearing will be to give citizens an opportunity to make their comments known on the program and for approval of the Program Income Reuse Plan. The Hampton Board of Selectmen, on behalf of the Town of Hampton anticipates applying for up to \$600,000 under the Housing Rehabilitation category for the continuation of the Regional Housing Rehabilitation Program, to rehabilitate homes in any of the following towns: Hampton, Brooklyn, Chaplin, Eastford, Pomfret and Scotland. The Town may also utilize program income generated from prior grants in accordance with the Town's Program Income Reuse Plan.

The Town of Hampton promotes fair housing and makes all programs available to low- and moderate-income families regardless of age, race, color, religion, sex, national origin, sexual preference, marital status, or handicap.

All are encouraged to attend. The hearing location is accessible to persons with disabilities.
