**HB 7167** AN ACT CONCERNING EDUCATION FUNDING introduced by Education Committee

**HB 5001** AN ACT CONCERNING THE QUALITY AND DELIVERY OF SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES IN CONNECTICUT introduced by Education Committee

**SB 860** AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR EASTCONN introduced by Senator Heather Somers.

Committee members will contact legislators regarding the three bills, particularly Senator Gordon who supports provisions to hold towns harmless in ECS grants.
