QUALIFICATIONS FOR ENTRY:

- Hampton resident (If a group, one member must be Hampton resident.)
- Age five (5) and older.
- Prior winners may perform but are ineligible for prizes.

WHAT'S YOUR TALENT: Dance, Vocal: with/without background music, solo/with group, etc. comedy, puppetry, duo, etc. All instruments allowed, except for piano (keyboard allowed), juggling, plate spinning, gymnastics, yodeling, poetry, obviously anything goes (within reason).

CONDITIONS AND PARTICIPATION: Participants must understand and recognize the risks of physical injury inherent in dance or other performance and be willing to assume responsibility for their participation at their own risk. It is agreed and understood that participants will not hold the Hampton Recreation Commission nor the Town of Hampton liable for injuries sustained while participating

ENTRY FEES:

Single Entry: \$5 per person
Double Entry: \$7.50 per double
Group Entry: \$15 for group of 3 or more

All fees are paid with application

No refunds given for no-shows

Each "Act" needs an application not each person

Make checks payable: Hampton Recreation Commission

LENGTH OF ACT: Performance times shall not exceed (5) minutes.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: Each participant may only enter for one act.

PRIZES: First Prize \$100, Second Prize \$50, Third Prize \$25

COSTUME/APPAREL/MAKE-UP/BACKSTAGE & DRESSING AREAS: All participants must be present and ready to perform in costumes. Also, all participants must show up in dress costume that is appropriate for a family show. No dressing room will be available.

CHECK-IN TIME: Participants are required to check in 30 minutes prior to their scheduled performance. All participants must bring any music on CD if needed for performance. Any participant who is a no-show will be disqualified and no refund will be given.

JUDGING: All participants will be scored following each performance by a panel of judges. Entrants agree that the time, manner and method of scoring shall be solely within the discretion of the Judges. Communication between entrants, friends, parents is absolutely restricted. If an act is not completed for any reason except for mechanical or technical difficulty, the act will not be judged nor rescheduled for re-performance. Acts will not be scored or penalized for legitimate delay.

There will be a total of 3 judges. All scores will be confidential. An independent person will tally up the points for each contestant. If there is a tie, then a tie-breaker will be initiated. All scores are final.
